EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE SCHOLARSHIP

A program established to provide assistance for members of Vietnam Veterans of America (VVA), and Associates of Vietnam Veterans of America (AVVA), in the state of Virginia, and their children, grandchildren, stepchild or children under legal guardianship and have definite plans to continue their education. The Vietnam Veterans of Chapter 1061 will award one non-renewable scholarship annually in the amount up to \$500.00.

Eligibility Rules

- 1. Applicant must be a spouse, child or grandchild (natural, step or adoptee), or a child who is under the guardianship of a VVA or AVVA member of Chapter 1061. A member or surviving spouse of VVA or AVVA Chapter 1061 is also eligible to apply. The VVA or AVVA member or surviving spouse in the State of Virginia must be in good standing during the physical year.
- 2. To be considered for the scholarship, applicants must meet the following conditions:
 - A. The member/sponsor must be an active member of Chapter 1061, attend six (6) monthly meetings within a physical year, and help with Chapter 1061 fundraisers.
 - B. The member/sponsor will be responsible for repayment of the scholarship funds if the applicant does not attend an accredited school or program and fails to complete the first semester.
 - C. The member/sponsor will be responsible for ensuring that the application is filled out correctly and submitted on time for review.
 - D. It will be at the discretion of the committee chair to return an application or notify the applicant that the application is not complete.
 - E. Applicants must be registered as a full-time student and accepted into an accredited college, trade School, vocational institution or accredited program.

- F. A copy confirming the applicant's registration must be submitted with the application.
- G. The scholarship committee reserves the right to verify the credibility of the selected educational program.
- 3. Awards will be based on consideration and completion of the following factors:
 - A. Approved by the Scholarship Committee and educational program verified.
 - B. Two letters of recommendation, one (1) from a sponsoring member of Chapter 1061 and one (1) from an outside source.
 - C. The Chapter will award \$500.00 scholarships to six (6) new applicants not to exceed a \$3,000.00 limit.
 - D. First time scholarship applicants considered before previously awarded scholarship applicants.

HOW TO APPLY

- 4. Applicants must submit the application prior to May 15th and be postmarked on or prior to this date:
 - A. A properly completed application for a scholarship.
 - B. Two letters of recommendation (as described above).
 - C. Verification of the member/sponsor's responsibilities as listed.
 - D. Completed application and all required documentation must be submitted to:

SELECTION

If there are more than six (6) applicants, a random drawing of all new applications will be made at the monthly meeting of Chapter 1061 Vietnam Veterans of America in June. A first and second alternate will be selected if the scholarship applicant is unable to accept the award.

FAILURE TO SUBMIT THE REQUIRED CRITIERIA WILL LEAD TO THE APPLICATION DISQUALIFICATION.
